



SURVIVORSHIP WARRANTY DEED

in consideration of THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS - - - - - - received from grantees, does grant, bargain, sell convey and confirm unto

Joseph G. Roberts and Mabel Roberts, Husband and Wife as joint tenants with right of survivorship, and not as tenants in common, the following described real property in ______SCOTTS__BLUFF______County, Nebraska:





Lots Numbered Nine (9), Ten (10), and Eleven (11), CHAUTAUQUA ADDITION No. 1, an Addition to the City of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, according to the recorded plat thereof,

Subject to all easements and restrictions of record.





To have and to hold the above described premises together with all tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the grantees and to their assigns, or to the heirs and assigns of he survivor of them forever.

And grantor does hereby covenant with the grantees and with their assigns and with the heirs and assigns of the survivor of them that grantor is lawfully seised of said premises; that they are free from encumbrance

that grantor has good right and lawful authority to convey the same; and that grantor warrants and will defend the title to said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

It is the intention of all parties hereto that in the event of the death of either of the grantees, the entire fee simple title to the real estate shall vest in the surviving grantee.
