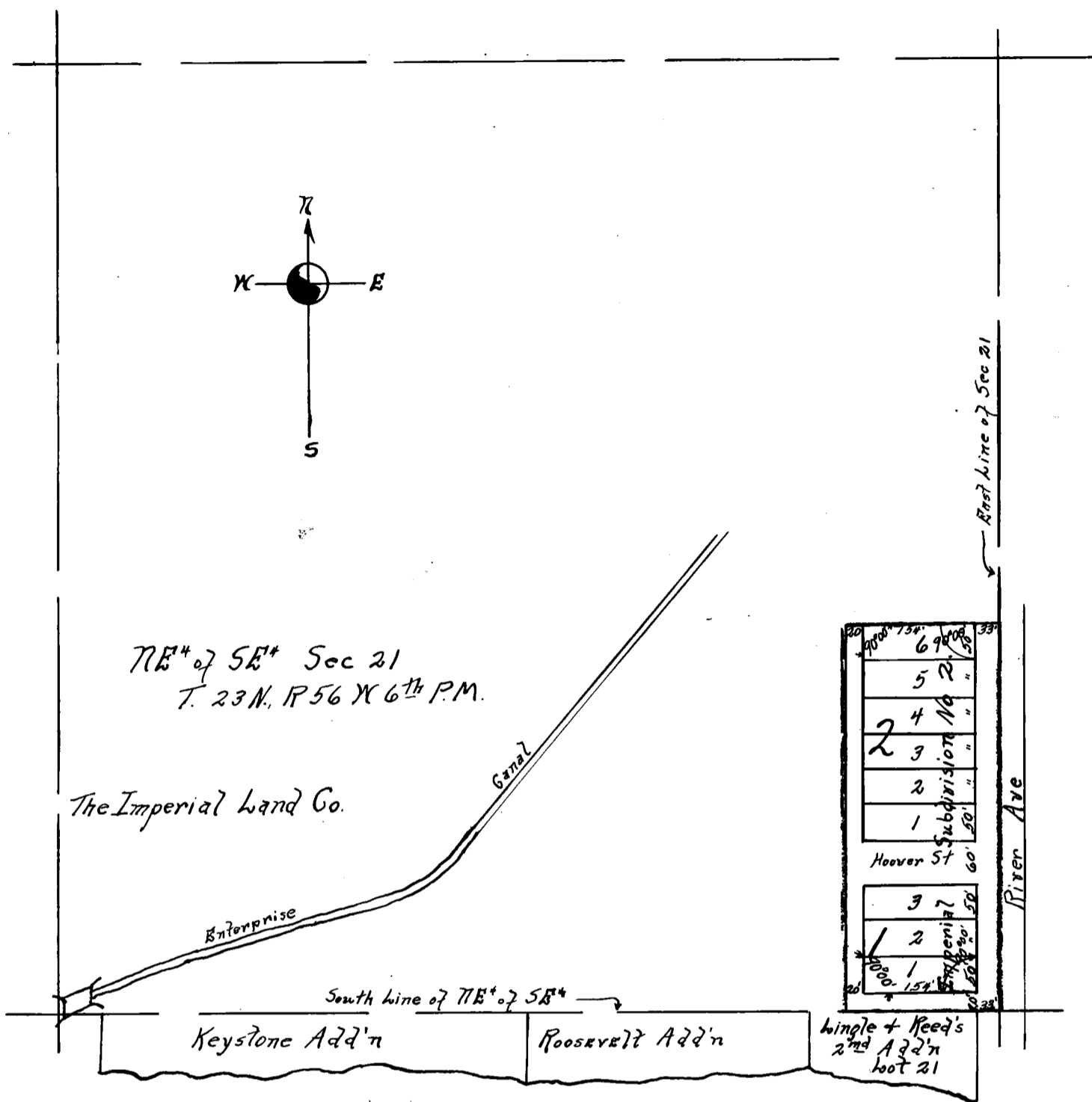

I hereby certify that on the 15th day of May, 1920, I surveyed for subdivision that part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, Township 23 North, Range 56 West of the 6th P.M., Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, shown on this plat as Imperial Subdivision No 2, to the Town of Mitchell, Nebraska, as is clearly indicated on this plat drawn on a scale of one inch equal to 200 feet. The dimensions of all lots, streets and alleys are clearly indicated and each lot and block bears its own number.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That The Imperial Land Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Nebraska, is the present owner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-one (21), Township twenty-three (23) North, Range fifty-six (56) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, County of Scotts Bluff, State of Nebraska, in the Southeast corner of which this addition and sub-division is made as shown by this plat and the foregoing surveyor's certificate.

That the streets and alleys shown on this plat, which have not heretofore been dedicated, are hereby dedicated to the Public use, the undersigned, The Imperial Land Company, hereby expressly reserving, for itself, its successors and assigns the right to construct, maintain and operate irrigation pipe lines, ditches and laterals, in, along or across any or all of the streets and alleys shown on this plat.
