I, the undersigned do hereby certify that on March 22 to 25th inc 1922 I surveyed the First Braziel addition to LYMAN, NEBRASKA, and subdevided said addition into lots, blocks, streets, and alleys as is herein shown.

That the corners of said Lots and Blocks are well marked with fir stakes

(13x13 inches) driven flush with the surface of the ground.

That the measurements of said lots blocks and streets are as herein given. That the N W and NE corners of said Sec 3 T 22 N R 58 W are well marked with

cement posts set flush with the surface of the ground.

Then beginning at the NW cor said Sec 3 I run in an easterly direction on line between said Sec 3 and Sec 34 T 23 N R 58 W to the point of intersection with the center line of Jeffers Ave (distance 1550.3 feet) point A on map.
