SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, M. C. Schaff, a competent surveyor of Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, hereby certify that I have surveyed and subdivided a part of the East Half of the Northwest Quarter ($E_7^4NW_4^4$) of Section Nine (9), Township Twenty-Two (22) North, Range Fifty-Five (55) West of the Sixth (6th) Principle Meridian (P.M.), Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, the boundary of such survey and subdivision being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the North Quarter corner of Section 9; thence, Southerly, along the North-South Centerline of Section 9, a distance of 1,537.03 feet to the point of beginning; thence, continuing along the last described course, a distance of 293.27 feet; thence, a deflection angle right of 125 degrees 41 minutes 20 seconds, a distance of 941.96 feet; thence, a deflection angle right of 08 degrees 06 minutes 00 seconds, a distance of 517.48 feet; thence, a deflection angle right of 90 degrees 27 minutes 50 seconds, a distance of 302.9 feet; thence, a deflection angle right of 90 degrees 53 minutes 10 seconds, a distance of 271.1 feet; thence, a deflection angle left of 04 degrees 08 minutes 30 seconds, a distance of 974.9 feet, to the point of beginning, containing an area of 8.72 acres, more or less.
