
MATHSON SUBDIVISION 5495

I, Kenneth George Roberts, a competent surveyor of Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, do hereby certify that I have surveyed a tract of land situated in the Southwest Quarter (SW1) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Fifty-six (56) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in the City of Mitchell, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 40 rods (660) feet) east of the southwest corner of such Section Twenty-two (22); thence North and parallel with the west line of such Section, a distance of 20 rods (330 feet); thence east 8 rods [132 feet); thence South 20 rods (330 feet); thence west 8 rods (132 feet) to the point of beginning; subject to the right of way of U.S. Highway No. 26 on the south 33 feet of such tract, Such tract is designated as Tax Lot 10 in the Irregular Tract Book of unplatted lands in the County Surveyon's Office of Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska.

That I have prepared a plat of subdivision of such land to be known as *MATHSON SUB-DIVISION, Block One (1), Lots 1, 2, & 3, in the City of Mitchell, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska.

That the accompanying plat is a correct delineation of such survey drawn to a scale of 100 feet to one inch with all dimensions shown thereon in feet and decimals. That each lot and block bears its own number and $5/8^{\circ}$ iron rods are driven well into the ground at each lot corner.

That the boundary of the subdivision is shown on the plat with a heavy solid line and adjoining properties are shown with dashed lines for orientation purposes only.
