RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS

TO

FIRST BLUFFS ADDITION

TO

THE CITY OF SCOTTSBLUFF, NEBRASKA

- I, the undersigned, J. William Westervelt, single, being the owner of all of First Bluffs Addition to the City of Scottsbluff, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, do hereby place the following protective covenants on all of said Addition:
- A. All of said lots in said addition shall be known and described as residental lots. No structures shall be erected, altered, placed, or permitted to remain on any residential building plot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two stories in height and a private garage for not more than two cars.
- B. No building shall be located on any residential plot nearer than 25 feet to the front lot line, nor nearer than 5 feet to any side street line. No building shall be located nearer than 5 feet to any side lot line, except that the side yard space may be not less than two feet for a garage or other outbuilding located 60 feet or more from the front lot line. No residence or attached appurtenance shall be erected on any lot farther than 30 feet from the front lot line.
- C. No residential structure shall be erected or placed on any building plot, which plot has an area of less than 5,000 square feet nor a width of less than 50 feet at the front building setback line.
- D. No noxious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried on upon any lot nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or nuisance to the neighborhood.
- E. No persons of any race other than the Caucasian race shall use or occupy any building or any lot, except that this covenant shall not prevent occupancy by domestic servants of a different race domiciled with an owner or tenant.
- F. No trailer, basement, tent, shack, garage, barn, or other outbuilding erected in the tract shall at any time be used as a residence temporarily or permanently, nor shall any structure of a temporary character be used as a residence.
- G. No dwelling costing less than \$2,000.00 shall be permitted on any lot in the tract. The ground floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open porches and garages shall be not less than 576 square feet in the case of a one-story structure nor less than 550 square feet in the case of a one-half or two-story structure. No used or "second hand" structures of any kind shall be moved or placed upon any lot in the tract nor may used or "second hand" material be incorporated into structures erected upon any lot in the tract.
- H. These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on all the parties and all persons claiming under them until January 1, 1975, at which time said covenants shall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten years unless by a vote of the majority of the then owners of the lots it is agreed to change the said covenants in whole or in part.
 - I. If the arties hereto or an of them or their heirs or assi ns shall

or attempt to violate any of the covenants herein it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any real property situated in said development or subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenant and either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages or other dues for such violation.

J. Invalidation of any one of these covenants by judgment or court order shall in no wise effect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
