FOX-MOLINE ADDITION TO MORRILL, NEBRASKA

I hereby certify that, on the 21st day of August, A. D. 1919, I surveyed the FOX-MOLINE ADDITION to MORRILL, NEBRASKA, a subdivision located in the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Fifteen (15), in Township Twenty three (23) North, Range Fifty seven (57), West of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, as shown by the foregoing plat attached hereto, which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of One hundred (100) feet to an inch. A correct description of said addition by meets and bounds being as follows: Beginning at the iron stake marking the center of Section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Fifty seven (57) West of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian and running east Nine hundred thirteen (913) feet on a line between the center of and the Quarter Section Corner on the east side of Section Fifteen (15), Township Twenty three (23) North, Range Fifty seven (57), West of the Sixth (6th) Principal Meridian, thence North Ninety (90) degrees for Seven Hundred fifty (750) feet; thence West Nine Hundred ten and eight tenths (910.8) feet on a line parallel to the South line to the North-South Quarter Section line between the center of and the Quarter Section Corner on the North side of said Section; thence South Seven Hundred fifty (750) feet to the center of said Section, the point of beginning.

The width of streets, avenues, alleys and lots are as indicated on the plat, dimensions being shown by feet and decimals of feet. Each lot and block bears its own number. White oak and fir stakes, interspersed are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot.
