



A part of Lot Three (3), Section Two (2), Township Twenty-one (21), North, Range Fifty-five (55), West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the north line of said Section Two (2), where the extension north of the west line of the alley along the west side of Block "E" in North Park Addition to the town of Gering, Nebraska, according to the recorded plat thereof, intersects said north section line (said point being about 1.9 feet west of an iron pin driven in the ground at the northeast corner of said Lot Three (3); thence South along said west alley line about 473 feet to intersect the extension west of the north line of T Street of the City of Gering; thence west along the extension of the north line of said street a distance of 315 feet; thence north parallel with the west line of said alley about 479 feet to intersect the north line of said Section Two (2); thence east along said north line to the point of beginning, platted as Hinshaw Addition to the City of Gering, Nebraska,
