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ORDINANCE NO. 1113

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSBLUFF, NEBRASKA, VACATING A TWELVE AND ONE-HALF (12.5) FOOT ALLEY ABUTTING LOTS ONE (1), THREE (3), FOUR (4), AND FIVE (5), DOOLEY'S SUBDIVISION OF LOT FIVE (5) AND THE NORTH HALF (N $\frac{1}{2}$) OF LOT FOURTEEN (14), BLOCK ONE (1), MILLER PLACE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SCOTTSBLUFF, NEBRASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SCOTTSBLUFF, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. The following-described alley in the City of Scottsbluff, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska:

A tract of land abutting Lots One (1), Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5), Dooley's Subdivision of Lot Five (5) and the North half (N $\frac{1}{2}$) of Lot Fourteen (14), Block One (1), Miller Place Addition to the City of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, according to the recorded plat thereof, which tract is more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot Four (4) of Dooley's Subdivision; thence in a northerly direction along a projection of the west line of said Lot Four (4) a distance of twelve and five-tenths (12.5) feet; thence east and parallel with the north line of said Lot Four (4) and Lot Five (5) of Dooley's Subdivision a distance of one hundred sixteen (116) feet; thence in a southerly direction along a projection of the east line of said Lot Five (5) a distance of twelve and five-tenths (12.5) feet; thence west along the north line of said Lot Five (5) and Lot Four (4) a distance of one hundred sixteen (116) feet to the point of beginning,

is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
