THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Samuel Willard Houston of Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office Sidney, Nebraska whereby it appears that FULL PAYMENT has been made by the said Samuel Willard Houston according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the Sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the South East quarter of Section Nineteen in Township Twenty One North of Range Fifty Four West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Nebraska, containing one hundred sixty acres according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel Willard Houston.

Now Know Ye, That the United State of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity to the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Samuel Willard Houston and to his heirs, the said tract of Land above described; To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging unto the said Samuel Willard Houston and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I Benjamin Harrison, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
