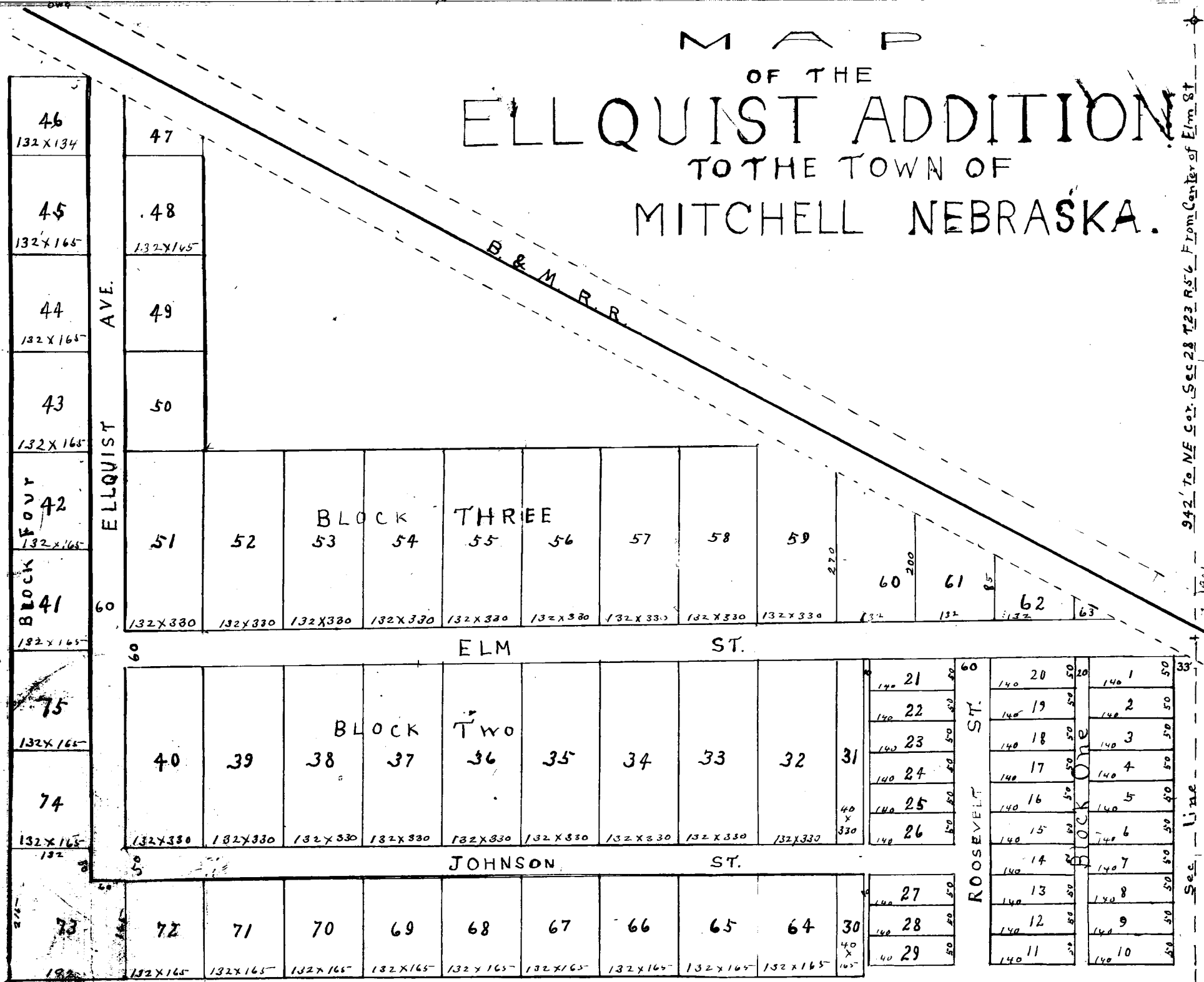


DEED RECORD.

This is to certify that on the 18th day of March A.D. 1907 I surveyed Ellquist Addition to the town of Mitchell, situated on a part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28 in Township 23 North of Range 56 West of the Sixth principal Meridian, which is clearly shown by the foregoing plat which is a correct delineation of said survey drawn to a scale of 200 feet to the inch. The streets are laid out parallel with and at right angles to the section line of said quarter of said section 28. The stakes are driven well into the ground at each corner of each lot. The width of streets and alleys and dimensions of lots are indicated in feet and decimals on the plat each lot and block bears its own number.
