I hereby certify that on the 14th and 15th days of Nov. 1905 I surveyed First Addition to Mitchell, situate on a part of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27 T. 23 N.R. 56 W. as shown by the foregoing plat which is a correct delineation of said Survey drawn to a scale of 250 feet to an inch. The Streets and avenues are extensions of those of same name is the original town, Cedar and Maple avenues are parallel with Walnut avenue. Burr oak stakes all Asn driven well into the ground, at the front corners of

each lot and stone is planted at the point designated on the plat and at the NW and NE corners of said Sec. 27 (being 5500feet apart.)
