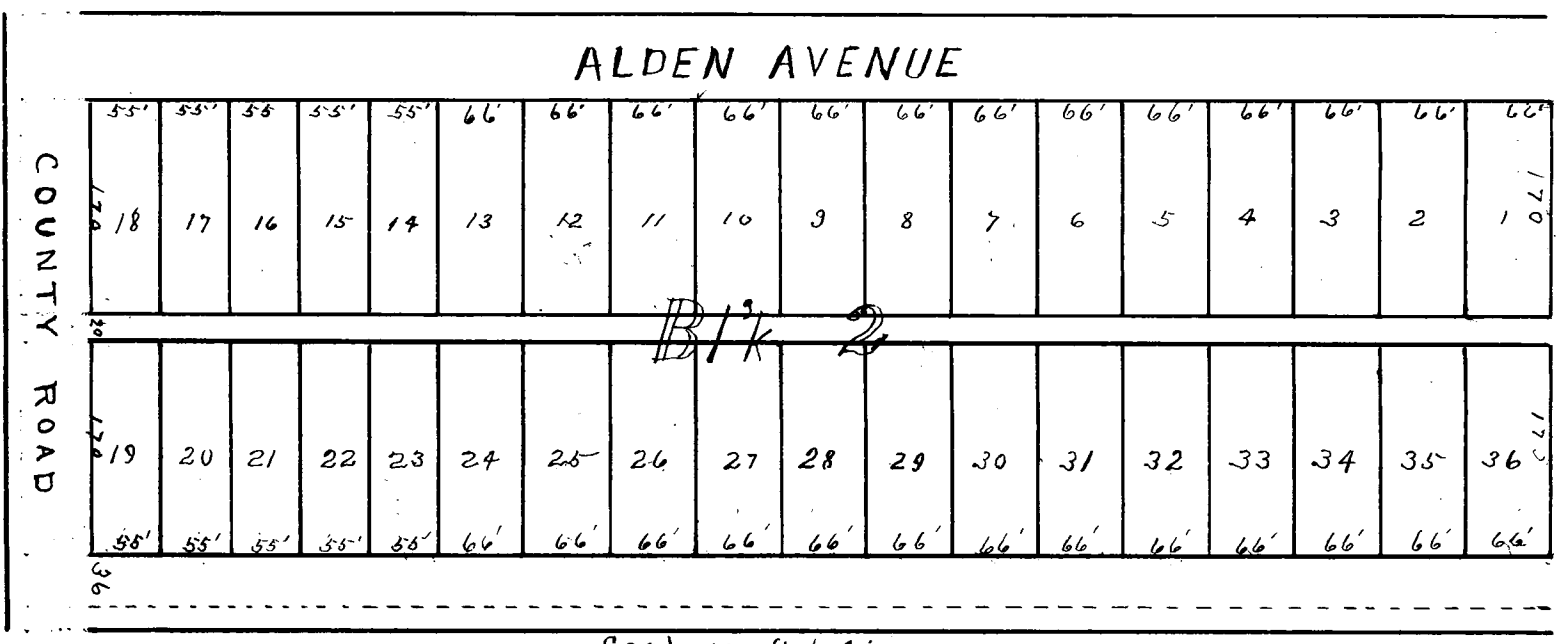

I, A. B. McCoskey do hereby certify that the above plat correctly represents the
 subdivision of lots 2,3,4,5,6,7,8, & 9, blk. 2, in MILLER PLACE and consists of a part of the
 NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25 T. 22 N. R. 55 W., described as follows: Beginning at a point 924
 ft. S. (va. 15 15') and 33 ft. E. (va. 15 58') from the NW corner of said sec. thence E. (va. 15 58')
 1122 ft. thence S. (va. 15 15') 396' ft. thence W. (va. 15 58') 1122 ft. thence N. (va. 15 15') 396
 ft. to the place of beginning and containing 10.2 acres; that the above plat was made from
 notes made during an actual survey made by me on the 24th day of July 1907; that each lot
 bears its own number; that pine stakes were driven firmly into the ground at the front corners
 of each lot and that the dimensions of the lots and the width given for street and alley
