

DEED RECORD R, SCOTTS BLUFF COUNTY.

I hereby certify that on the 24,27, 29 and 30th days of December, 1912 I surveyed the town of Haig Nebraska, situated in the East 1/2 OF Section 13, Township 22 North Range 56 West of the 6 P. M. which is clearly shown by the accompanying plat, which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 200 feet to 1 inch. The streets running North and South are parallel with the East line and the streets and the alleys running East and West are parallel with the East and West 1/2 Section line of the above Section 13 except along the right of way of the Union Pacific Railroad where the angle of the street is shown on the plat. White pine stakes were driven well into the ground at the front and rear corners of all lots except at corners indicated with letters I. P. on plat. Corners indicated on plat by letters I. P. are marked on the ground by iron pipe driven flush with the ground. The width of streets and alleys and dimensions of lots are indicated in feet and decimals by black figures on the plat.
