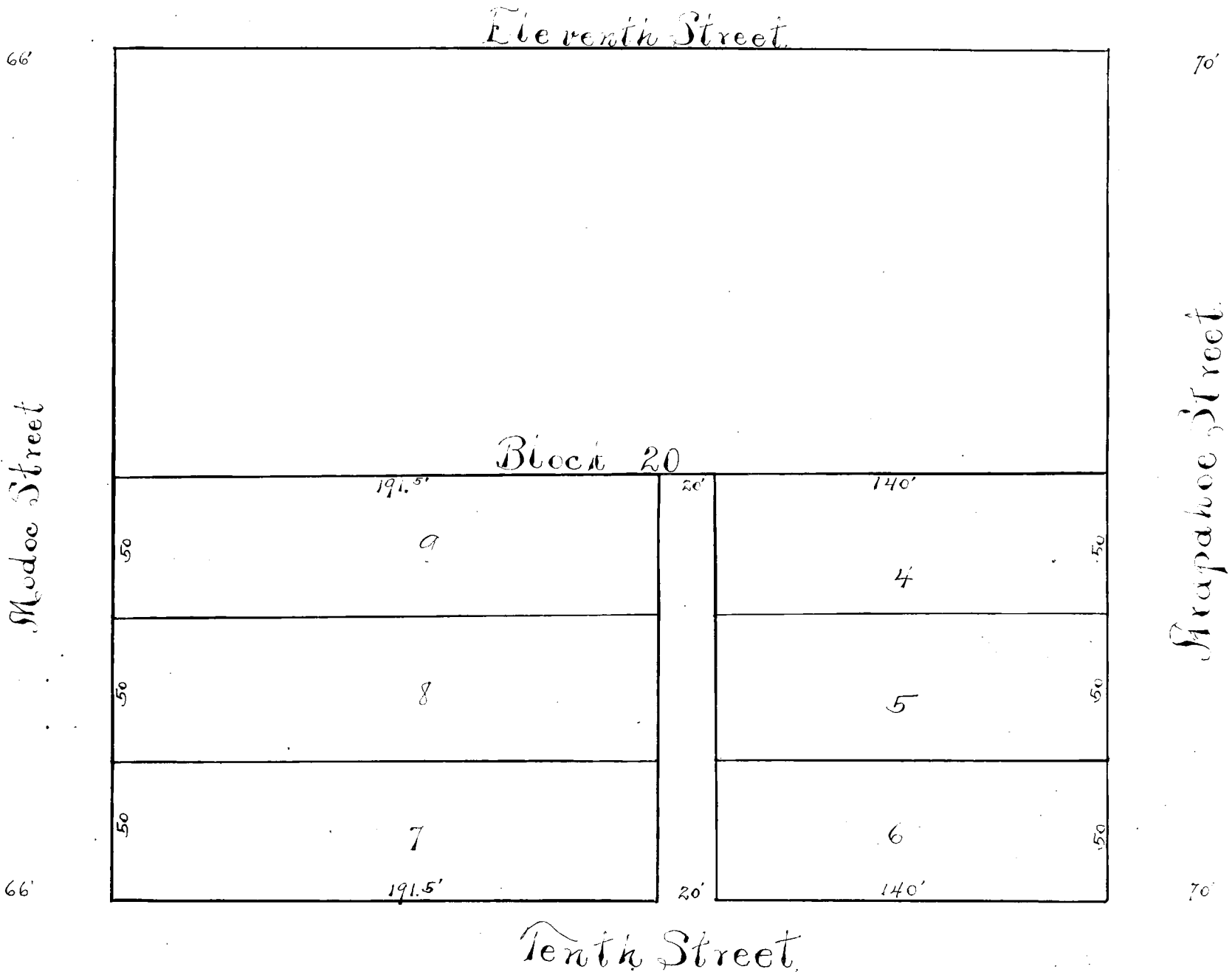


DEED RECORD T, SCOTTS BLUFF COUNTY.

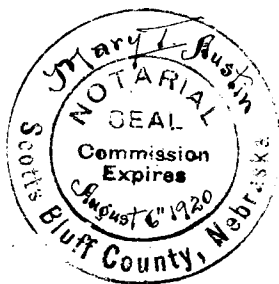
