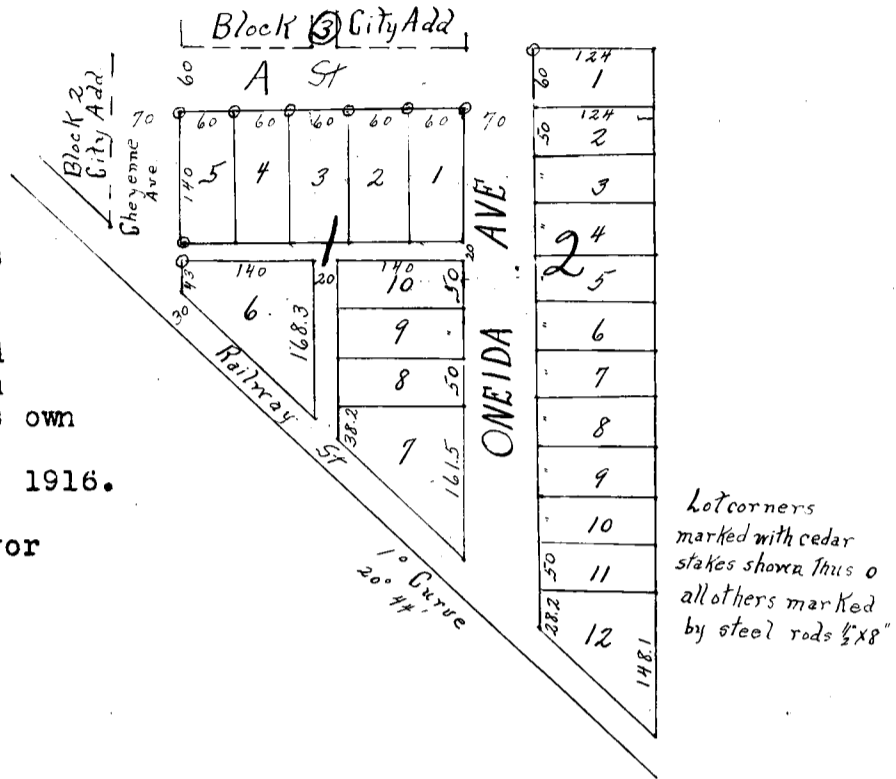
## COUNCIL ADDITION TO SCOTTSBLUFF

SCOTTS BLUFF CO NEBR

I hereby certify that during the month of December 1916, I surveyed Council Add. to the City of Scottsbluff situated in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 26 T. 22 W. R. 55 W of the 6th Principal Meridian as shown by the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of the said survey drawn to a scale of 200 ft to the inch The streets and Avenue are Extensions of the same name in the Original Town and Additions thereto. White Cedar stakes are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The width of Streets, Avenue and Alleys, and dimensions are indicated in feet and decimals by figures in black ink on the annexed plat. Each lot and block bears its own number.

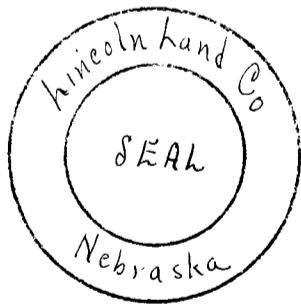
