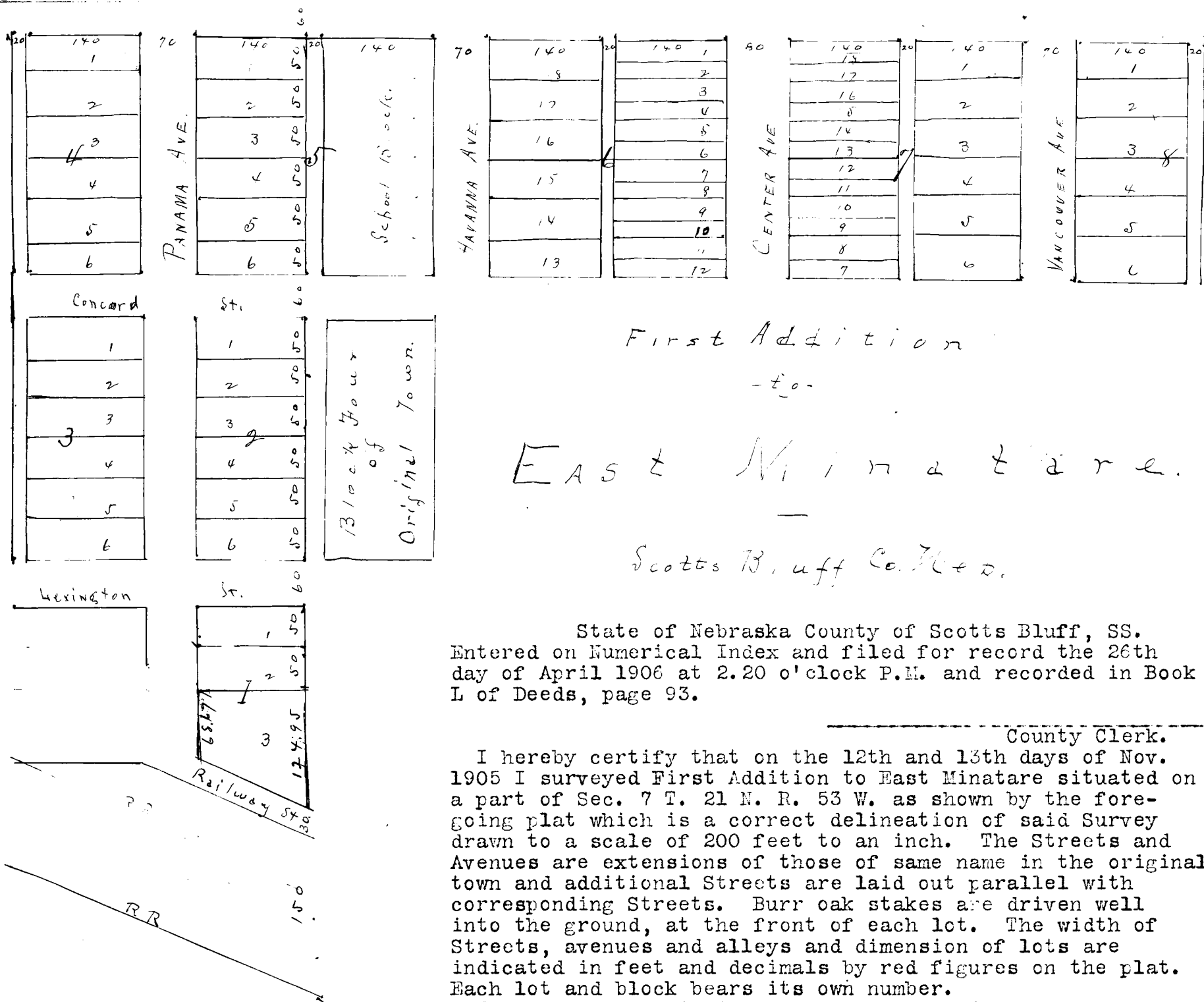


DEED RECORD.

 Entered on Numerical Index and filed for record the 26th
 day of April 1906 at 2.20 o'clock P.M. and recorded in Book
 L of Deeds, page 93.

 I hereby certify that on the 12th and 13th days of Nov.
 1905 I surveyed First Addition to East Minatare situated on
 a part of Sec. 7 T. 21 N. R. 53 W. as shown by the fore-
 going plat which is a correct delineation of said Survey
 drawn to a scale of 200 feet to an inch. The Streets and
 Avenues are extensions of those of same name in the original
 town and additional Streets are laid out parallel with
 corresponding Streets. Burr oak stakes are driven well
 into the ground, at the front of each lot. The width of
 Streets, avenues and alleys and dimension of lots are
 indicated in feet and decimals by red figures on the plat.
 Each lot and block bears its own number.
