

## SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Ronald L. Vogel, a competent surveyor of Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, hereby certify that I have surveyed Steen Addition, Lots One through Ten, Block One, an addition to the Village of Morrill, Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, situated on a part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SENNEN) of Section Sixteen (16), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Fifty-seven (57) West of the Sixth (6th) P.M., Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, the boundary of such subdivision being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East Line of such SENNER such point being situated 393.0 feet North of the Southeast corner of such SENNER; then, North on the East line of such SENNER, a distance of 360.0 feet; then, a deflection angle to the left of 90 degrees 02 minutes 30 seconds, a distance of 473.0 feet; then, a deflection angle to the left of 89 degrees 57 minutes 30 seconds, a distance of 360.0 feet; then, a deflection angle to the left of 90 degrees 02 minutes 30 seconds, a distance of 473.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing an area of 3.91 acres, more or less.
