

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## SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE

I, Ronald L. Vogel, a Nebraska Registered Land Surveyor, hereby certify that a survey was made under my direction of part of the Southeast Quarter (SE%) of the Northeast Quarter (NE%) of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Twenty-three (23) North, Range Fifty-five (55) West of the 5th P.M., Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, more particularly described as follows:

With namemence to the Northeast Corner of the SE% NE% of such Section 34; then West along the North Line of such SE% NE% a distance of 40.20 feet to the Point of Beginning; then South 00 degrees 00 mintues 00 seconds East along the West Right-of-Way Line of Highway 71 a distance of 320.00 feet; then North 69 degrees 36 mintues 27 seconds West a distance of 328.59 feet; then North 54 degrees 36 mintues 27 seconds West a distance of 300.00 feet; then North 23 degrees 39 mintues 30 seconds East a distance of 160.99 feet to the North Line of the SE% NE%, Section 34; then South 89 degrees 36 minutes 27 seconds East along the North Line of such SE% NE% a distance of 509.80 feet to the point of Beginning, containing an area of 3.62 acres.
