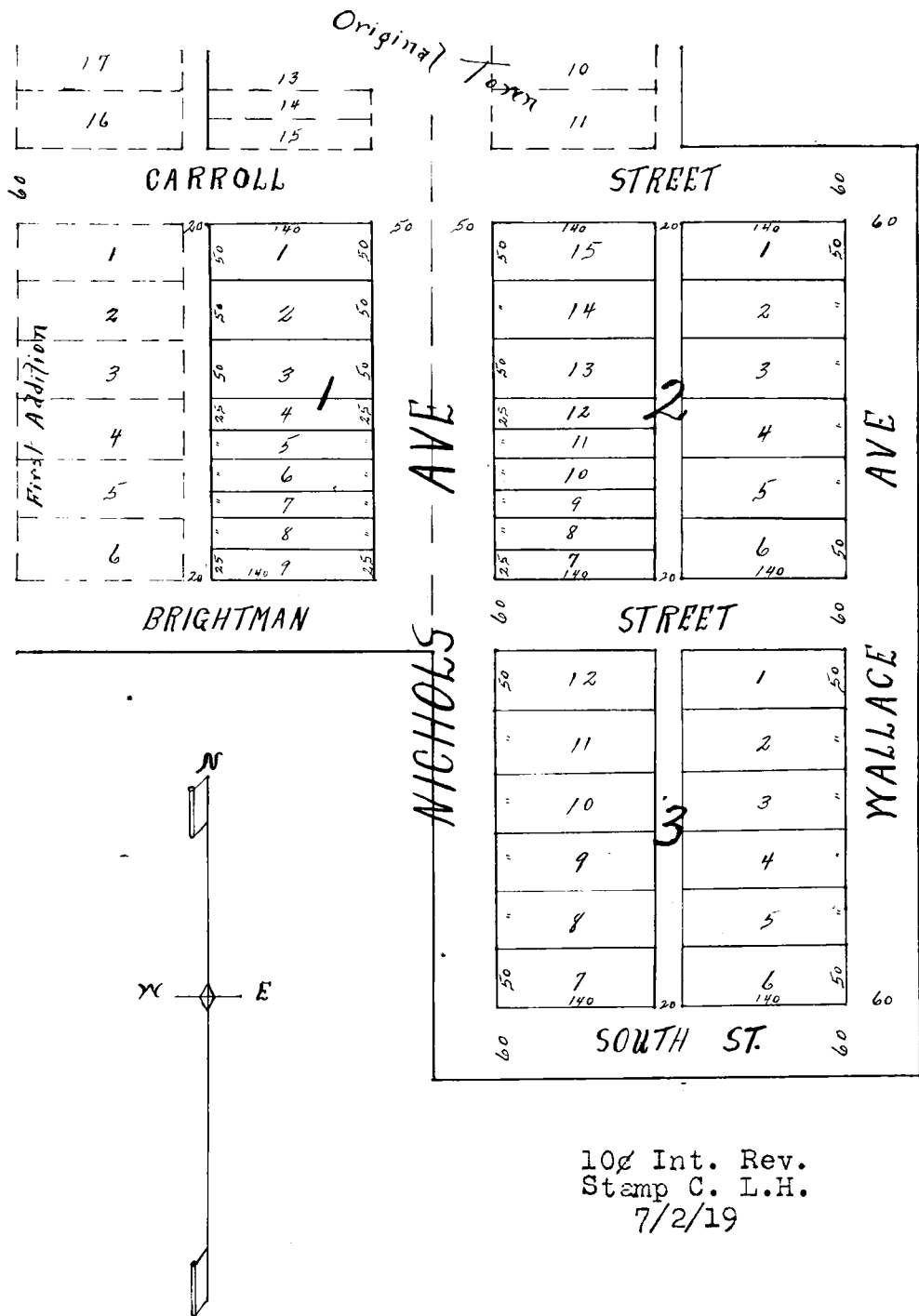

PLAT OF SECOND ADDITION TO HENRY, NEBRASKA.

I hereby certify that, in the month of June, 1919, I surveyed the Second Addition to the town of Henry, Nebraska situated in Sections 3&4, Township 23 North Range 58 West of the 6th P.M., Scotts Bluff County Nebraska, as shown by the annexed plat, which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 150 feet to an inch, correction description of which is as follows: Commencing at the south-west corner of Lot 15, Block 2 in the town of Henry, Nebraska, and running thence south to the south line of Brightman Street; thence east 190 feet to the section line between said Sections 3&4; thence south along said section line 360 feet; thence east 410 feet to the east line of Wallace Ave, thence North 780 feet to the north line of Carroll Street and thence west to the point of beginning. Cedar stakes are driven well into the ground at each lot corner. The widths of streets and dimensions of lots are indicated in feet on the annexed plat, Each lot and block bears its own number.

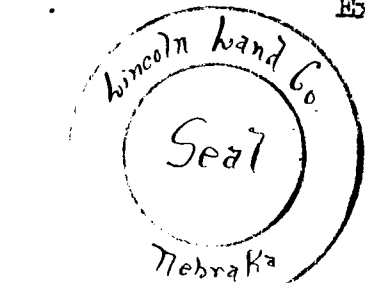
