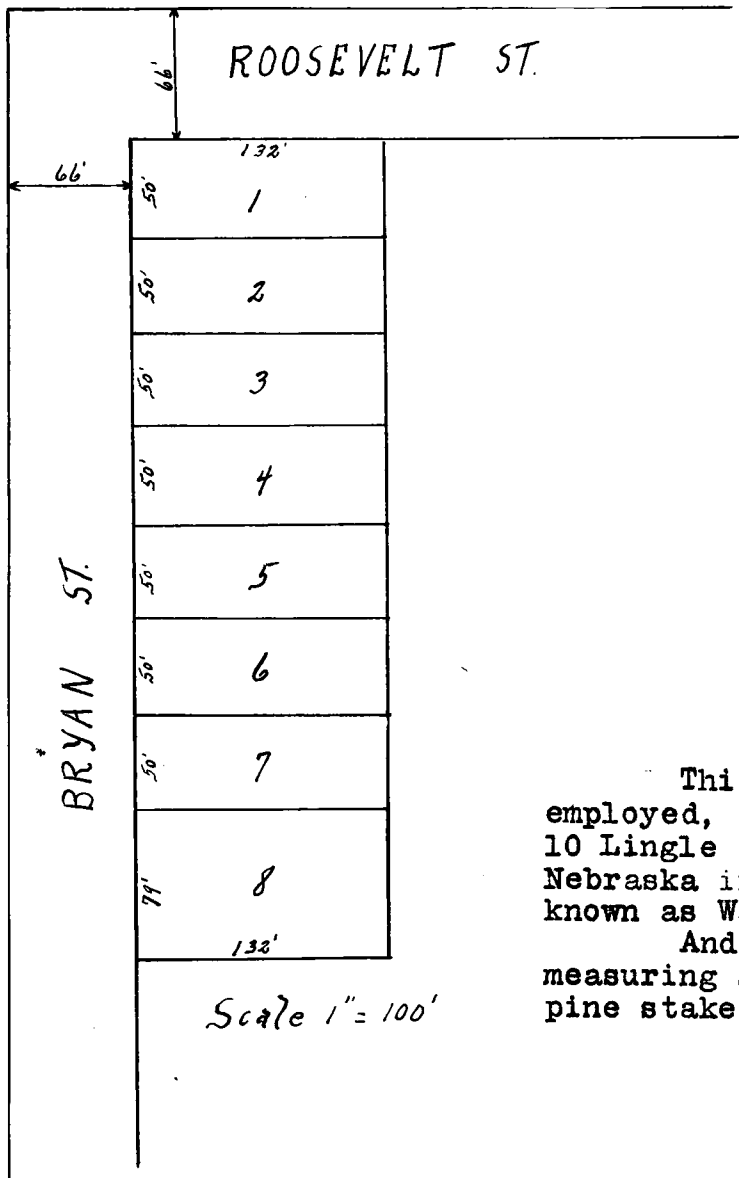

C E R T I F I C A T E

This is to certify that I John K. Rohrer was duly employed, civil engineer, by I. F. Warner to subdivide Lot No 10 Lingle and Reid's Second Addition to the City of Mitchell, Nebraska into residence lots, said tract to be hereafter known as Warner's Addition.

And that on November 23 1919, I made the survey, measuring all distances as shown on this plat and drove a pine stake 1" square and 12" long at each lot corner.
