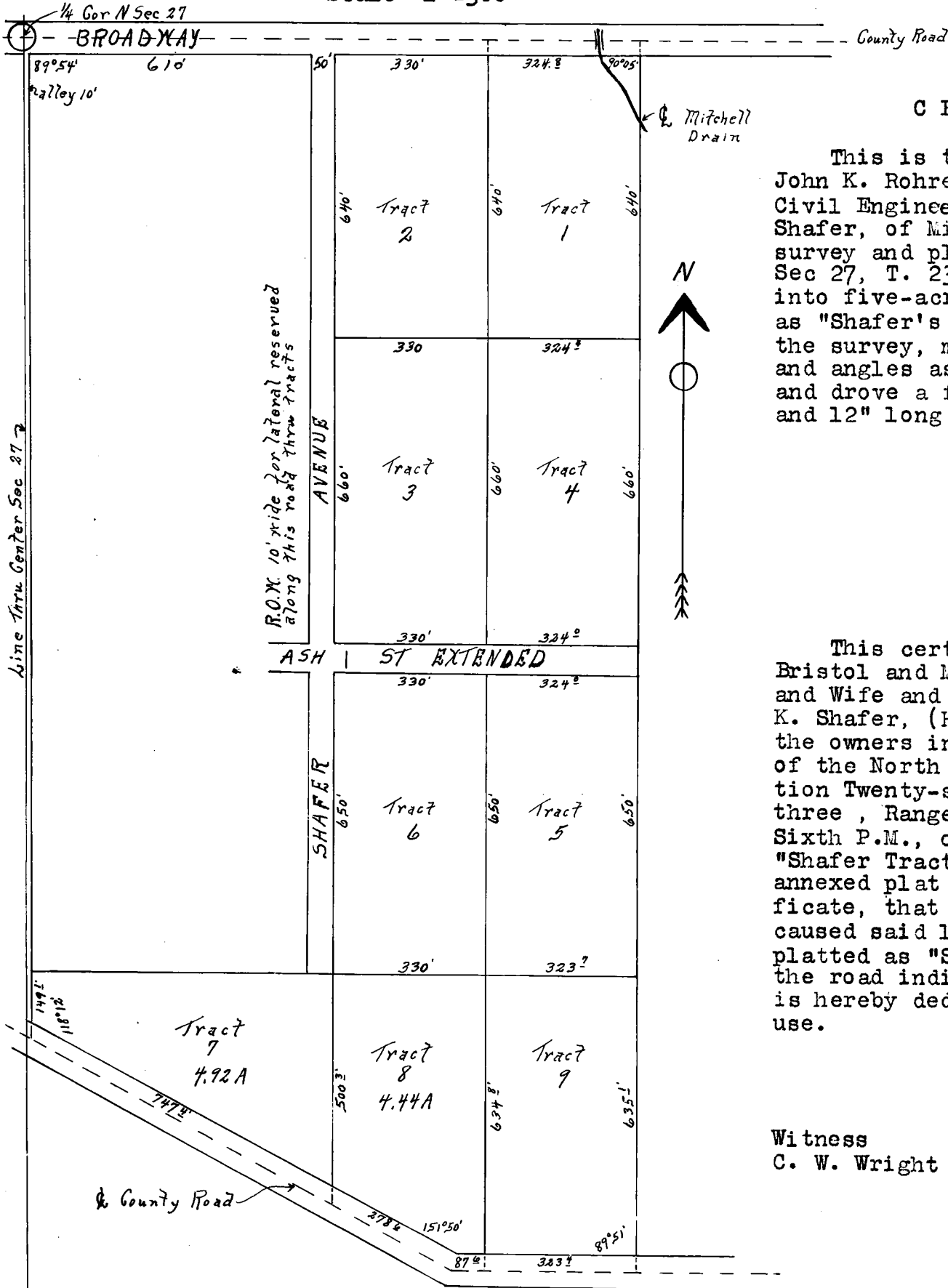

This is to certify that I, John K. Rohrer was duly employed Civil Engineer, by Bristol and Shafer, of Mitchell, Nebraska, to survey and plat a part of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 27, T. 23 N., R 56 W., 6th P.M. into five-acre tracts to be known as "Shafer's Tracts" and that I made the survey, measuring all distances and angles as shown on this plat and drove a fir stake 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and 12" long at each lot corner.
