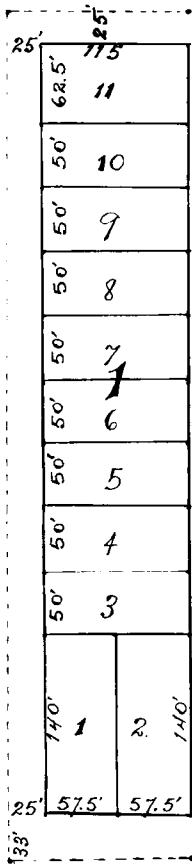

WESTERVELT'S SECOND ADDITION TO SCOTTSBLUFF.

I hereby certify that on the 27th day of April, 1911 I surveyed WESTERVELT'S SECOND ADDITION to SCOTTSBLUFF which is a part of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, T. 22 N., R. 55 W. of the 6th P. M., Bounded as follows: Beginning at a point 346.5 ft. East and 33 ft. North from the S. W. corner of said Section 24, thence North 627.5 ft., thence East 140 ft. thence South 627.5 ft., thence West 140 ft. to the place of beginning; that the accompanying plat is a correct delineation of said survey; that said tract is divided as shown by said plat; that Oak stakes are driven into the ground at the front corners of each lot; that the numbers and dimensions of the lots are as indicated by figures on the plat.
