
## DEED RECORD R, SCOTTS BLUFF COUNTY.



# THORNTON'S FIRST ADDITION to GERING, NEBRASKA.

I hereby certify that in the month of February, 1912, I surveyed Thornton's First Addition to Gering, situated on a part of the West-half ( $W_2^1$ ) of the North-west Quarter ( $NW_4^1$ ) of Section One (1) in Township Twenty-one (21), North, Range Fifty-five (55) West of the Sixth Principal Meridian as shown by the foregoing plat which is a correct delineation of said survey, drawn to a scale of 200 feet to an inch.

The Streets and Alleys are laid out parallel with and at right angles to the West line of saod North-west quarter section, except Market Street which is parallel with the Union Pacific Railroad. Oak Stakes are driven well into the ground at the corner of each Block and Iron stakes at the corner of each lot. The width of Streets, Avenues and Alleys and dimensions of lots are indicated in feet by red figures. Each lot and block bears its own number.
