

I hereby certify that on the twenty first day of October 1917 I surveyed the Second Addition to the Village of Morrill, Nebraska situated in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 15 T 23 N, R.57 W. of the 6th Principal Meridian as shown by the annexed plat which is a correct delineation of the said survey drawn to a scale of 200 feet to the inch. The streets and Avenues are extensions of the same name in the First Add. McKinley St is parallel with Hamilton St. Red cedar stakes are driven well into the ground at the front corners of each lot. The width of streets avenues and alleys and dimensions are indicated in feet and decimals by figures in black ink on the annexed plat. Each lot and block bears its own number.
