Summary of verbal or written comments received during the hearing will be compiled and written comments may be submitted for 15 days following the hearing to Scotts Bluff County Public Transit at the address listed on the provided comment forms.
7. **Next Steps**
Following the 15-day comment period, comments will be reviewed by the Public Transit Manager and the Scotts Bluff County Board of Commissioners. The Board will determine the next course of action regarding fare increases and finalize their decision at the September 8th Board of Commissioners' meeting.
8. **Adjournment**
